

In Arizona Committee of Safety,

Rock Springs, December 2, 2011.

W *HEREAS the Preservation of our State from Slavery, depends under God, on an effectual Execution of the State and County Measures for that Purpose;*

RESOLVED, That there be now appointed for each County in this State, a Committee consisting of Five Persons, any Three of whom to be a Quorum, whose Business it shall be, to receive from the Committees of Safety in their respective Counties, a State of the Conduct of the Towns and Reservations, with Respect to their having executed the Committees Of Safety Plans as aforesaid ; and it shall be the Duty of said Committees to meet (Suggested) on the first Wednesdays of *January, February, March, April, May, June, July* and prepare a Report of the same, to be laid before the Committee at it's then next Session, that any Neglect of such Towns and Districts in executing such Plans, may be speedily and effectually remedied.

Also, **RESOLVED**, That it be, and it is hereby strongly recommended, to the Committees of Safety in the several Towns and Reservations in this State, some Time before the first Wednesday (Suggested) in *January, February, March, April, ETC.* aforesaid, to render to any one of the Members of their County Committees aforesaid, a true State of the Conduct of their respective Towns and Districts, with Respect to their having executed each Plan recommended by the State and County Committees Of Safety ; and to use their utmost Diligence for this important Purpose.

And whereas some Towns and Reservations in the State may be destitute of so excellent an Institution as Committees of Safety:


